OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

National Collection Week this year is Monday, November 12 through Monday, November 19. Sign-up sheets are ready for volunteering during this time. One or two hours (or more if you are able) at the sign-in table is one way to help. We can especially use very strong people to help load the trucks towards the end of the collection period. Give me a call (570-522-0973) or email me (<u>aim123@ptd.net</u>) if I haven't reached out to you as yet and you are available to lend a hand.

Shoebox Sunday at First Presbyterian Church is November 18th. Bring your packed boxes to the worship service and place them at the end of any pew. At the beginning of the worship service all the children will gather the shoeboxes and bring them to the front of the sanctuary. There, Pastor Barb will lead us in praying for them before they travel to their special destinations.

In 2017, 19,846 boxes passed through our collection center and were shipped from here to the Baltimore, MD Processing Center. The Mid-Atlantic Region (PA, NJ, DE, MD, and VA) collected a total of 1,161,471 shoeboxes. From Baltimore they were shipped to Rwanda, Malawi, Barbados, South Africa, Kenya, Ukraine, Burundi, Bahamas, Haiti and Lesotho.

The parent organization of Operation Christmas Child is Samaritan's Purse. Monetary donations may be made online at samaritanspurse.org, or checks payable to Samaritan's Purse may be placed in the offering plates and we will see that they are delivered.
