

# MISSION TRIP 2019 FINANCIAL UPDATE

Thank you to everyone who has been supporting our youth mission trip prayerfully and financially. Unfortunately, as with many programs here at the church, there have been cuts to the Youth Mission Trip. The total cost for this year's mission trip is \$15,409.31. While coming from a variety of sources, over \$5,600 has been cut from Youth Mission Trip funding. This represents about a third of the total cost of our trip. Based on our fundraising averages from last year and fundraisers we already have planned or are underway, it would take roughly 10 more fundraisers between now and the end of May to recover this amount.

While the original estimates have each student paying \$268, based on what we have fundraised <u>so</u> <u>far</u> this year and the cuts that were made, the cost per student rises to \$592.00 – an amount that will not be doable for most, if not all, of our youth.

In the coming weeks and months, this insert will show accounting of how much we have fundraised and how far left we have to go. Please prayerfully consider if you and your family may be able to help fund this summer's mission trip.

**Total Cost for Trip** - \$15,409.31

**Cost per student** – ( $$268.00 \times 18 \text{ spots}$ ) = \$4,824.00 covered by students

#### Guatemala Medical Mission Trip January 19 – 26, 2019

Our Guatemala Medical Mission team had a wonderful week! We visited 3 villages over the course of 4 days and served more than 450 villagers. After working with these villages for 14 years, it was wonderful to be able to visit the families again and see how the children have grown! Our church took a group of 8 people from Pennsylvania (including Dr. Mark Speake, Emma Heid, and Amber Lind from the congregation). We



joined with 3 doctors and a nurse from Colorado. One of the Colorado doctors is Dr. Joel Strohecker, Judith Zeigler's nephew, who visits Guatemala regularly and works in a local clinic started by Kairos and Joel. While in Guatemala, some of the doctors worked at the clinic and the rest of us visited villages on the mountain. Each villager is given de-worming medicine and vitamins, and additional medicine as prescribed by the doctors. In addition to providing medical care, we had fun playing with the children. Coloring, bubbles, nail painting, and board games were extremely enjoyable, despite the language barrier. Mark was also able to visit Juan and his family at their home. We're happy to report he is doing well. When we left his village on the last day, Juan was out playing soccer with some of the other boys! We really appreciate everyone who have supported the trip!
