Fellowship of Christian Athletes (Bill Morrow) The Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) was established in 1954 with the goal of seeing the world impacted by Jesus Christ through the influence of Coaches and Athletes. Today, FCA reaches over 80 countries around the world and has a long history of impact here in the U.S. Through our method of engaging, equipping and empowering Coaches and Athletes to grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ, we are seeing individuals, teams and

communities transformed through God's work in FCA.



Bill Morrow is the Area Representative for FCA in the upper Susquehanna Valley. His role with FCA is to grow a ministry presence at local schools, colleges and club teams. FCA campus ministries are currently present at Lewisburg and Shikellamy High Schools and at Bucknell University. Next school year will see the start of new campus ministries

at two additional colleges and at several public schools. These ministries will be led by coaches, equipped and empowered by Bill's discipleship. Bill left his corporate position in the summer of 2018 and works full time for FCA. No stranger to athletics, Bill has competed in multiple sports and has coached football at the college, high school and junior levels for nearly 25 years. He currently is a coach with the Lewisburg School District.



Youth Summer Mission Trip (Matthew Rishell) Each summer, Refuge (First Presbyterian's high school youth group) spends a week serving a community in need around the United States. Past trips have included Schenectady, NY, Valdosta, GA, Elizabeth City, NC and Woonsocket, RI. For the past several years, we have partnered with Group Mission Trips and have had a tremendous experience each year from the worship times, to the devotionals, to meaningful projects. The youth are split up into work crews comprised of students from youth groups from around the country. Although we don't know which project we will be working on until the first night, we do anything from painting to roof repair. The youth mission trip offers a great opportunity for the members of the youth group to learn what it means to serve and to escape the comfortable environment of Lewisburg and be challenged to grow more in their faith.





Heart to Hand Ministries (Woody Wolfe) Heart to Hand Ministries was started in 1992 by Woody Wolfe, Jr. and a few friends, after Woody had spent nearly eleven years visiting hospitalized children in a children's hospital in his home town of Danville. Initially, Woody found that music was a way to give these kids back a piece of their childhood that is so often snatched from them in these situations. Woody's mission now is to reach out through music, word and service, with the love, compassion and Good News of Jesus Christ to those who are in the midst of trial, especially children who are suffering from critical and chronic illnesses and their families. His hope is also to encourage others to use their own unique God-given gifts to reach out to a troubled, hurting world.

Woody ministers weekly at the Janet Weis Children's Hospital in Danville, Penn State Children's Hospital in Hershey and Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. Each Friday he provides music for the Central PA Aphasia Center and various nursing facilities in and around Danville. He also visits St. Christopher's Hospital for Children in Philadelphia, PA, Phoenix Children's Hospital in Phoenix, Arizona, Carillion Hospital in Roanoke, Virginia and Palmetto Richland Cancer Center in Columbia, South Carolina. More recently he has taken on outreach into the central United States with visits to Arkansas Children's Hospital in Little Rock, Arkansas, St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee and Children's Hospital Colorado in Aurora, Colorado. For thirty-five years, Woody has also provided music for various special needs/medical camps in Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Virginia, Georgia, Florida, Arizona, Montana, Idaho, Indiana, Minnesota, Michigan, Missouri and Hawaii. Kairos Ministries (Gustavo & Elizabeth Valdez) Gustavo, a native of Guatemala, and his wife Elizabeth, a native of Pennsylvania, are founding officers of Kairos Ministries Guatemala, USA. Both grew up as children of pastors and, when they married, felt led to enter full time into ministries along with Gustavo's parents. Kairos Ministries Guatemala, USA is associated with Asociacion Kairos in Guatemala, which was founded by Gustavo's parents over 25 years ago. The ministry is multi-faceted and includes operation of the Kairos House, the Clinica Camotan and leading short term mission trips to Guatemala. The Kairos House was established by Gustavo's parents to provide a Christian environment for families of patients receiving cancer services at the public hospital in Guatemala City, along with other individuals who are receiving other medical treatments. Many of these people travel several hours from their homes and have no place to stay other than the streets surrounding the hospital. The Kairos House staff ministers to both their physical and spiritual needs in their time of crisis. The clinic opened in November of 2017 in partnership with Dr. Joel Strohecker. The clinic serves as a FREE HEALTH clinic, meeting the needs of the town and those who live in the remote villages of the nearby mountain. 
