As the church's seasonal calendar goes, we are heading into "Ordinary Time." That's a strange way of saying that from June 6th until November 14th, no major Christian holidays or celebrations (i.e. Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter, Pentecost) change the decoration of our sanctuary, or the time and day of our worship services. The paraments that hang from the pulpit and cover the communion table will be turned to green and will stay that way for almost six months.

"Well, OK," you may be thinking, "Good to know. But so what?"

While "Ordinary Time" sounds kind of boring, it doesn't have to be! During these 'ordinary' months, we can break from the lectionary's holiday-based schedule of preaching texts and explore some of the Bible's less-commonly known stories and characters. Instead, we can plan to talk about issues and topics that aren't related to preparing for Jesus' birth, or in anticipation of his passion, death, and resurrection.

The 'so what' of "Ordinary Time" is this – as I prepare my preaching schedule for the "green" Sundays of summer and into the fall, I'd love to know what you're eager to hear about. The 20 (or so) minutes each Sunday that I explore God's word with you are the most meaningful, privileged moments of my ministry. And I want them to be relevant and important and informative to you, too.

So let's take these months ahead of us to answer pressing questions, sharpen our theological insight, and better equip ourselves to share the gospel with a world really confused about who God is, and about the consequence of God's love for us in Jesus Christ.
