2 Timothy 3:16

Everything in the Scriptures is God's Word. All of it is useful for teaching and helping people and for correcting them and showing them how to live.

Then, it was in print but not in the language of the people. Congregations relied on the religious leaders to pass on and interpret God's message.

I am grateful for the opportunity to be surrounded by God's Book. I also value the devotionals, novels, studies and audio tapes and videos contained in the library.
